Texas Shorthorn Association Elite Heifer Sale RULES

-TSA membership must be current for each breeder to nominate heifers.

-Heifers must be purchased from TSA Elite Heifer Sale with a TSA breeder that has active membership.

-Heifers must be transferred from the original TSA breeder to a junior exhibitor.

-Heifers will only qualify for one year of eligibility and must be the first available TSA Elite Heifer Show.

-Each heifer entry fee \$200 (Texas) & \$250 (out of state fee) paid by February 3rd. NO LATE ENTRIES.

-TSA will promote heifers on TSA Facebook and website at no charge.

Consign a heifer to a TSA sanctioned sale:

-Must have nomination fee paid, have animal picture/video at approved location.

Place an ad on the TSA Facebook:

-The ad price is \$50 per head for social media.

To nominate selected heifers:

-Maximum of 20 head will be sold. The spots will be on a first entry form submitted basis. TSA will post notification once all 20 spots are filled.

-All nomination and advertisement fees are non-refundable

-All fees collected are put towards a purse and additional sales fees will be deducted from the sale of the heifer.

-Each exhibitor will receive a check regardless of place standings

Exhibitors:

-Each exhibitor is required to be a TJSA member (dues must be current)

-Each exhibitor must submit an entry application by entry deadline. Entry application, copy of registration paper, and must be returned to TJSA.

Texas Shorthorn Association sale committee will maintain the right to ensure quality show heifers are entered in this event. TSA reserves the right to retrieve DNA for parentage verification on all.
