TSA News

It's Membership dues time again for all Texas Shorthorn Associations!!!

Remember, if your junior wins Ft. Worth Junior Shorthorn Show on January 20, 2024 the TSA pays a \$1250 scholarship but parents must be a member of TSA or Lassie and junior must be a TJSA member for 2024. So dues have to be paid prior to the show on January 20, 2024. There are no exceptions to this rule!

The last TSA meeting was held in conjunction with the State Fair in Dallas on 10/22/23. Several things were discussed:

- 1) Ft. Worth Open Shorthorn show was changed to Saturday, Jan. 27 @ 3pm which completely changes the usual schedules of the TSA & Lassie meetings, the Lassie silent auction fundraiser and the social which has always been on the Saturday prior to the Sunday shows.
- 2) State Futurity online sale will be held in March (date to be determined) and the actual

futurity show will be held in conjunction with the Tri-State Livestock show in September so that all who buy a heifer will be eligible to show regardless of what state they live in. The number of heifers to be sold will be limited to 20 and the application paperwork and nomination fee of \$200/head need to be submitted by the Ft. Worth Open Shorthorn show. Eric is comprising a selection committee for approving eligibility for the sale. Cash prizes will be awarded to all that show again this year. Other prizes may also be given to exhibitors. Updated information will be available in this newsletter each month.

- **3)** Victoria Osburn has been working on creating a Google Doc for breeders to fill out to maintain conformity in the information added to the website. As soon as it has been completed, it will be released to the members. This will keep all the information posted on the "Breeders Section" on the website consistent. Remember, if you do not keep up your TSA membership every year, your farm information will be removed. This is a perk of the membership like the newsletter.
- **4)** The change of the Ft. Worth Livestock show was discussed in the meeting since it has changed so many events that have been the same for many years. The TSA meeting will be held on Friday, Jan. 26 from 2:30-4:00 in the McFarland room as usual. The yearly Lassie Silent Auction and Social will follow the meeting. The Lassie meeting will be by a ZOOM meeting on January 11, 2024 @ 7-8pm.

NEXT TSA MEETING AGENDA

The January meeting at Ft. Worth will be the usual busy meeting with many things to accomplish. There will be the final information on the Futurity sale announced. The Pioneer and Progressive Breeders will be nominated so be thinking of who you would like to nominate for these breeder awards. Pioneer breeder is someone who has been breeding and selling their Shorthorn cattle for many years, been involved in the TSA and promoted the Shorthorn breed.

We will also be nominating new board members so, if anyone is interested in becoming a TSA BOD, please let the nomination committee, President, Secretary, or anyone currently serving on the board know your interest. The requirements are to be a TSA member in good standing for at least a year and attend at least ½ of the four yearly board meetings. TSA has started to hold ZOOM meetings in the evenings so that more people can be present for decisions that need to be made. Secretary, Tracey Laughery, is also sending out emails for voting on different issues and if board members continue to send their votes back by email in a timely fashion, that venue has worked well.

association in good financial standing and election of 2 new board members, Tyler Cates & Cory Bollum.


