



## Texas Shorthorn Association Elite Female Futurity Sale

1. All consignors must be a paid member of the Texas Shorthorn Association prior to completing nomination form.
2. The nomination fee is \$150 which contributes towards the futurity cash prize. Cash prizes will be awarded for all class placings with Champion Female/Pair winning a grand prize of \$500.
3. Entry must be completed and paid by March 1, 2025 or entry will not be accepted or cataloged online.
4. TSA committee screens all sale entries prior to cataloging. A professional photo and video must be made available for cataloging with [sconlinesales.com](https://sconlinesales.com).
5. If you outbid your own entry to pass the given PO amount, you will be liable to pay the commission on that lot.
6. During the Tri-State Fair, entries must be entered in the Open Show to be eligible to show in the TSA Elite Female Futurity Show. The Tri-State Fair Open Show is September 12-14, 2025 in Amarillo, Texas. Show information and entry form will be available at <https://www.tristatefair.com/>
7. Heifer calf lots must be older than December 31st, 2024, but cow lots must not be older than January 1st, 2022.

8. For cow/calf pair entries, exhibitors must pick at the time of the show if they would like to show the cow/calf pair or the heifer calf. At the time of entry for the Tri-State Fair and futurity show, the committee will need to know how the entry from the sale will be presented. I.e. heifer prospect or cow/calf pair.
9. If you have a purebred shorthorn cow that has a shorthorn plus calf on its side, then that pair will be shown in the shorthorn plus division.
10. The consignor is responsible for transferring papers to the owner.
11. Each consignor accepts the responsibility of guaranteeing their own cattle to be in sound condition and have the privilege of giving additional guarantee on cattle at the time of sale. TSA acts only as an agent for the consignors in the sale and does not assume any responsibility for the animal's future usefulness. All guarantees are strictly between the buyer and seller.
